

PREPARING FOR YOUR TMP

STEP 1: ORGANIZE YOUR GROUP

WHAT WILL YOU BE ARGUING FOR?

ORDER YOUR LENSES: DECIDE WHAT ORDER MAKES SENSE TO MAKE YOUR POINT.

WHAT ARE YOUR POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS? (LIMITATIONS AND IMPLICATIONS OF EACH!)

WHAT IS YOUR BEST SOLUTION? HOW WILL YOU ARGUE FOR THAT? WHAT EVIDENCE WILL YOU USE?

STEP 2: CREATE A SCRIPT

HAVE AN OPENING: HAVE A HOOK (QFSA). STATE YOUR RESEARCH QUESTION (WORD FOR WORD!)

CREATE "SCENE HEADINGS" SO YOU CAN KEEP TRACK OF YOUR ORDER (SIGNPOSTING)

CREATE "DIALOGUE": WHO WILL SAY WHAT AND WHEN?

- KEEP IN MIND THAT EACH SPEAKER MUST HAVE EVIDENCE WITH SOURCES AND ANALYSIS OF THE EVIDENCE, WITH MULTIPLE PERSPECTIVES IN MULTIPLE LENSES!
- HERE'S WHERE YOU NEED THAT IRR!

HAVE TRANSITIONS BETWEEN SECTIONS

ADDRESS SOLUTIONS, CONCLUSIONS, IMPLICATIONS AND LIMITATIONS (WITH EVIDENCE)

CALL TO ACTION: SO WHAT?

STEP 3: PRACTICE!

WHO WILL SPEAK FIRST?

HOW WILL YOU TRANSITION BETWEEN SPEAKERS?

ROTATE SPEAKERS/MEMBERS WHEN PRESENTING

MAKE EYE CONTACT, FACIAL EXPRESSION, GESTURES (FOR REAL)

MAKE SURE YOU PLAN PAUSES, DON'T RUSH!

HOW/WHERE WILL YOU STAND WHEN OTHER MEMBERS PRESENT?

STEP 4: BUILD YOUR SLIDES

SLIDES SHOULD BE FREE FROM ERRORS

SLIDES SHOULD BE CONSISTENT
